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# How to play

## Set up

Split into two teams. One person is the moderator — they hold this booklet (or the phone) and never plays. Each question has six hidden answers, ranked by how common they are.

## Scoring

Answer 1 is worth 30 points, then 25, 20, 15, 10, and 5 for the sixth. Read the question aloud and let the active team give one answer at a time.

## Three strikes and steal

A wrong answer is a strike. Three strikes and the other team gets one single guess to steal every point on the board for that question. If they miss, the points stay with the first team.

## Close enough counts

Accept reasonable equivalents — plurals, nicknames, and obvious synonyms. The online version does this automatically.

## Winning

Play an even number of questions so both teams moderate the same amount. Highest total wins. Ties are broken with one sudden-death question.
